



Optomap® Retinal Scan

The Optomap® Retinal Scan produces images that provide the doctors with a wide view to look at the health of your retina which further aids in detection and prevention of retinal pathology. Diseases such as Macular Degeneration, Glaucoma, retinal tears or detachments, and other health problems such as diabetes and high blood pressure can now be seen without dilation for most patients. The scan is fast, easy, and comfortable for all ages.



These tests are especially important if you have:
