



At Keelan Eye Care, the health and well-being of our patients are our top priority. We are taking additional steps to keep patients and employees healthy and safe, including:

1. We have increased the frequency of cleaning and disinfecting of all surfaces throughout our facility and, as always, exam rooms are disinfected between patients.
 - One staff member is assigned to do infection control of space on the hour while masked and gloved.
 - ALL patients must wear a medical-grade mask upon entry into the office. If a mask is not worn, you will not be allowed to enter the building.
 - Hand sanitizing stations have been installed throughout our office, we are encouraging patients to use it upon check-in and throughout their visit in the office.
 - ALL eyeglass frames are disinfected by the Optician after each patient to avoid the spread of any germs.
 - ALL doors are open so patients and staff members are not touching handles.
 - ONLY family members with a booked appointment are allowed inside the office at this time.
 - Curbside service available for all pre-paid eyewear pick-up. Shipping via UPS is available for an additional \$10 on all eyewear.
2. Our staff practices good hygiene by covering coughs and sneezes, not touching their faces, and continuously washing their hands.
3. Management currently is mandating all sick employees to stay home to help prevent the spread of illness.

If you are feeling ill, we ask that you please call us before traveling to the office, so we can either reschedule your appointment, or in the case of an emergency, provide information on what to do upon arrival to the office.

We are closely monitoring the guidance from the Centers for Disease Control and local authorities regarding the spread of the virus to ensure that the actions that we are taking are comprehensive and appropriate.
